## Format

- **18-hole stroke play. Best ball gross.**
  - **Team must include one Mid Am player and one Senior Am player**
  - **Mid Am approximate yardage: 6,800**
  - **Senior Am approximate yardage: 6,400**
- **Filed limited to 48 teams**

## Entry Fee & Procedure

- **\$180 per team**
- **Range use & cart fees included**
  - **No practice round included**
- **No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse. All refunds are subject to a \$10 service fee**
- **Contestants, shall apply online at [CDGAGOLF.org](http://CDGAGOLF.org)**
- **Late or incomplete entries not accepted. No telephone or fax entries.**
- **Deadline for application is September 18, 2024 at 11:59 PM or when field is full**

## Eligibility

- **Must be a male member of a full-service OGA member club with an active WHS index.**
- **WHS index must not exceed 8.4**
- **Mid Am player must be between the ages of 25-54 as of September 25, 2024**
- **Senior Am player must be 55 or older on or before September 18, 2024**

## Tee Times

- **Requested groupings and tee times cannot be guaranteed**
- **Starting times will be sent via email to contestants approximately one week in advance and may also be found on [CDGAGOLF.org](http://CDGAGOLF.org)**

## Rules

- Rules of Golf will govern all play except for local rules approved by the CDGA

## Caddies & Transportation

- Golf carts and caddies are permitted
- Players may carry clubs if host club permits
- A player must not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round
  - Breach of Local Rules result in the general penalty for each hole during which the player is helped by such a caddie. If the breach occurs between holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. SEE MODEL LOCAL RULE 8H

## Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball

- Players may not wear the following shoes
  - Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground, regardless of material
  - Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. See Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7
- List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-1
- List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-3
