Format

- 18-hole qualifying stroke play on day one, with match play on day two.
 - Amateurs low 31 from qualifying round and 2023 Champion (if entered) will begin match play on day two
 - Senior Amateurs low 7 from qualifying round and 2023 Champion (if entered) will begin match play on day two
- Matches will continue on Wednesday with all final matches being played on Thursday
 - Field limit to 160 teams
 - Amateur Division approximate yardage of 6,739
 - Senior Am Division approximate yardage of 6,397
- 2024 Champion will be locally exempt for the 2025 U.S. Amateur.

Entry Fee & Procedure

- \$150 per player
- Range use & cart fees included
 - No practice round included
- No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse. All refunds are subject to a \$10 service fee
- Contestants, shall apply online at <u>CDGAGOLF.org</u>
- Late or incomplete entries not accepted. No telephone or fax entries.
- Deadline for application is July 18, 2024 at 11:59 PM or when field is full
- * ALL ENTRIES SHALL BE DEEMED AN INVITATION AND ARE SUBJECT TO BOARD ACCEPTANCE *

Eligibility

- Must be a male member of a full-service OGA member club with an active WHS index.
- Must have a WHS index of 8.4 or less
- Senior players must be 55 or older on or before July 22, 2024

Tee Times

• Requested groupings and tee times cannot be guaranteed

• Starting times will be sent via email to contestants approximately one week in advance and may also be found on <u>CDGAGOLF.org</u>

<u>Rules</u>

• Rules of Golf will govern all play except for local rules approved by the CDGA

Caddies & Transportation

- Golf carts and caddies are permitted
- Players may carry clubs if host club permits
- A player must not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round
 - Breach of Local Rules result in the general penalty for each hole during which the player is helped by such a caddie. If the breach occurs between holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. <u>SEE MODEL LOCAL RULE 8H</u>

Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball

- Players may not wear the following shoes
 - Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground, regardless of material
 - Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. See Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7
- List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-1
- List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-3
