# 2024 Ohio Senior Amateur Championship

Portage CC Akron, Ohio June 17-19



#### **Format**

- 36 Hole Stroke Play competition with two divisions
  - Practice Round Monday, June 17th
    - Afternoon shotgun. Entrants are permitted to create their own pairings and participate in an informal four-ball.
  - Round 1 Tuesday, June 18th
  - Round 3 Wednesday, June 19th
- Championship includes two divisions, played from different tees
  - Senior Division Ages 55+ Must have reached 55th birthday on or before June 18.
    - Approximate yardage: 6,314
  - Super Senior Division Ages 65+ Must have reached 65th birthday on or before June 18.
    - Approximate yardage: 6,033
- Champion of Senior Division exempt for 2024, 2025, and 2026 Ohio Amateur

### **Entry Fee & Procedure**

- \$340 Member fee, \$400 Non-member fee
- Range use and lunches included for Monday and Tuesday
- No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse. All refunds are subject to a \$15 service fee
- Contestants, shall apply online at <u>OHIOGOLF.org</u>
- Late or incomplete entries not accepted. No telephone or fax entries.
- Deadline for application is June 9, 2024 at 11:59 PM or when field is full
- \* ALL ENTRIES SHALL BE DEEMED AN INVITATION AND ARE SUBJECT TO BOARD ACCEPTANCE \*

### **Registration**

- Players must register at Portage CC on the date of the practice round, June 17th, 2024
- A player may call or email the OGA to pre-register, if he is unable to get to Portage CC on Monday. Failing to register may result in an alternate replacing that player.

### **Eligibility**

- Must be a male who has reached their 55th birthday on or before June 18, 2024
- Must be a resident of the state of Ohio
- All entrants must have a WHS handicap index of 7.4 or better
- In order to pay the member fee, entrants must have their WHS handicap established through an OGA member club. A list of member clubs can be found at <a href="OHIOGOLF.org">OHIOGOLF.org</a>
- A resident is defined as meeting four (4) of the following nine (9).
  - 1. Ownership or leasing of Ohio residence
  - 2. Proof of payment of utilities at property for which residency is being claimed
  - 3. Ohio homestead exemption declared on residence
  - 4. Place of employment in Ohio
  - 5. Ohio drivers license
  - 6. Ohio vehicle registration
  - 7. Ohio address listed on federal income tax return filed by player
  - 8. Has a WHS handicap at a golf club in Ohio
  - 9. Voter registration in Ohio

## **Caddies & Transportation**

- Caddies and carts are permitted. A player must not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round
  - Breach of Local Rules result in the general penalty for each hole during which the player is helped by such a caddie. If the breach occurs between holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. <u>SEE MODEL LOCAL RULE 8H</u>

### **Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball**

- Players may not wear the following shoes
  - Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground, regardless of material
  - Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. See Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7
- List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-1
- List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-3
