2024 Ohio Two Man Best Ball Championship

Format

- 36 Hole Championship with a field size of 176 players (88 teams)
 - Round 1 Monday, September 9th
 - Round 2 Tuesday, September 10th
- Championship includes three gross divisions and one net division
 - Overall Gross Play will be from the back tees
 - Senior Gross Players must be at least 55 years old on or before Sep. 9, 2024
 - Approximate yardage: 6,600
 - Super Senior Gross Players must be at least 65 years old on or before Sep. 9, 2024
 - Approximate yardage: 6,000
 - Net One division with two sets of tees
 - Ages 19-64 Approximate yardage: 6,600
 - Ages 65 & over Approximate yardage: 6,000
 - Handicaps will be adjusted to the proper tee for each player based on age
- Winning Team of Overall Gross division will be exempt for the 2025, 2026, and 2027 Ohio Amateur Championship
- Contact club after registering to schedule a practice round. Fee is \$75 including cart.
 - Tee times are based one club availability and are very restricted September 7 & 8.
 - One practice round per registered entrant.

Entry Fee & Procedure

- \$480/team Member fee, \$600/team Non-member fee
- Range use, cart fees, and lunches included for Monday, Tuesday
- No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse. All refunds are subject to a \$15 service fee
- Contestants, shall apply online at OHIOGOLF.org
- Late or incomplete entries not accepted. No telephone or fax entries.
- Deadline for application is September 3, 2024 at 11:59 PM or when field is full
- st st ALL ENTRIES SHALL BE DEEMED AN INVITATION AND ARE SUBJECT TO BOARD ACCEPTANCE st

Eligibility

- Must be a resident of the state of Ohio
- In order to pay the member fee, one member of team must have their WHS handicap established through an OGA member club. A list of member clubs can be found at OHIOGOLF.org
- A resident is defined as meeting four (4) of the following nine (9).
 - 1. Ownership or leasing of Ohio residence
 - 2. Proof of payment of utilities at property for which residency is being claimed
 - 3. Ohio homestead exemption declared on residence
 - 4. Place of employment in Ohio
 - 5. Ohio drivers license
 - 6. Ohio vehicle registration
 - 7. Ohio address listed on federal income tax return filed by player
 - 8. Has a WHS handicap at a golf club in Ohio
 - 9. Voter registration in Ohio

Caddies & Transportation

- Carts are permitted.
- A player must not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round
 - Breach of Local Rules result in the general penalty for each hole during which the player is helped by such a caddie. If the breach occurs between holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. <u>SEE MODEL LOCAL RULE 8H</u>

Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball

- Players may not wear the following shoes
 - Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground, regardless of material
 - Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. See Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7
- List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-1
- List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-3
