## Format

- **36-hole stroke play competition over two days, with three divisions and three separate tees. Gross and Net included in each division. Field limited to 40 players/division.**
  - **Mid-Amateur division; 25 or older with an approximate yardage of 6,500**
  - **Senior division; 55 or older with an approximate yardage of 6,100**
  - **Super Senior division; 65 or older with an approximate yardage of 5,980**
- **Round 2 pairings will be made according to round 1 scores for net and gross**

## Entry Fee & Procedure

- **\$180 For all divisions. Entrants are only permitted to enter ONE of the three competitions.**
- **Cart fees included for both rounds**
  - **Little Turtle does not have an outdoor range. Short game area and simulators only**
  - **No practice round included.**
- **No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse. All refunds are subject to a \$10 service fee**
- **Contestants, shall apply online at [CDGAGOLF.org](http://CDGAGOLF.org)**
- **Late or incomplete entries not accepted. No telephone or fax entries.**
- **Deadline for application is May 6, 2024 at 11:59 PM or when field is full**

## Eligibility

- **Must be a male member of a full-service OGA member club with an active WHS index.**

## Tee Times

- **Requested groupings and tee times cannot be guaranteed**
- **Starting times will be sent via email to contestants approximately one week in advance and may also be found on [CDGAGOLF.org](http://CDGAGOLF.org)**

## Rules

- **Rules of Golf will govern all play except for local rules approved by the CDGA**

## **Caddies & Transportation**

- **Golf carts and caddies are permitted**
- **Players may carry clubs if host club permits**
- **A player must not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round**
  - **Breach of Local Rules result in the general penalty for each hole during which the player is helped by such a caddie. If the breach occurs between holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. SEE MODEL LOCAL RULE 8H**

## **Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball**

- **Players may not wear the following shoes**
  - **Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground, regardless of material**
  - **Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. See Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7**
- **List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-1**
- **List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-3**
