Format

- Three separate 18-hole team events. Points awarded to top 10 each event. Total points after three events determines winning team. All play is scratch.
- Teams of 4 are made up of members of the same club competing for their home club
 - Rattlesnake Ridge GC Two man scramble, switch partners after the first nine
 - Worthington Hills CC Stableford, all four balls count
 - Northstar GC Two best balls of the four
- Field limited to 30 teams

Entry Fee & Procedure

- \$960 entry per team
- Range use and cart fees included in registration fee
 - No practice round included
- No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse. All refunds are subject to a \$10 service fee
- Contestants, shall apply online at CDGAGOLF.org
- Late or incomplete entries not accepted. No telephone or fax entries.
- Deadline for application is June 25, 2024 at 11:59 PM or when field is full
- * ALL ENTRIES SHALL BE DEEMED AN INVITATION AND ARE SUBJECT TO BOARD ACCEPTANCE *

Eligibility

- Must be a male member of a full-service OGA member club with an active WHS index.
 - Must be 19 years or older as of July 2, 2024
- Handicap index must not exceed 12.4 at time of entry
- All team members must be from the same club and approved by club staff

Tee Times

- · Requested groupings and tee times cannot be guaranteed
- Starting times will be sent via email to contestants approximately one week in advance and may also be found on <u>CDGAGOLF.org</u>

Rules

Rules of Golf will govern all play except for local rules approved by the CDGA

Caddies & Transportation

- Golf carts and caddies are permitted
- Players may carry clubs if host club permits
- A player must not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round
 - Breach of Local Rules result in the general penalty for each hole during which the player is helped by such a caddie. If the breach occurs between holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. SEE MODEL LOCAL RULE 8H

Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball

- Players may not wear the following shoes
 - Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground, regardless of material
 - Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. See Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7
- List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-1
- List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in affect. Local Rule G-3
