FORMAT

- 36-hole stroke play with Men's & Women's Division.
 - o Round 1 Monday, August 18
 - Round 2 Tuesday, August 19
- Men's Division approximate yardage of 6,750 yards.
- Women's Division approximate yardage of 6,000 yards.

ENTRY FEE & PROCEDURE

- \$80 Entry Fee for all entries
- Max field size of 84 total players.
- Range use, Cart fees & lunch included for Monday, Tuesday.
- No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse, all refunds are subject to a \$15 service fee.
- All contestants shall apply online at <u>OhioGolf.org</u> before the deadline.

National Links Trust Championship

Winner and Runner Up in each division will become exempt for the 2025 National Links Trust
 Championship, Presented by DICK'S Sporting Goods, October 24–26 in Washington, D.C at the Blue Course
 at East Potomac Golf Links. A travel stipend will be awarded to the Winner and Runner Up in each division.

All entries shall be deemed an invitation and are subject to board approval

ELIGIBILITY

- All entrants must have an active WHS handicap index of 8.4 or better for Men & 12.4 or better for Women.
- Must have a GHIN account active through a public or municipal course who is a member of Ohio Golf Association and meet the residency requirements listed below.
- Entrants must not have any practice or playing privileges at a private facility.
- All entrants must be 25 years of age or older on or before August 18, 2025.
- A resident is defined as meeting four (4) of the following nine (9).
 - 1. Ownership or leasing Ohio residence
 - 2. Proof of payment of utilities of property where residency is being claimed
 - 3. Ohio homestead exemption declared on residence
 - 4. Place of employment in Ohio
 - 5. Ohio driver's license
 - 6. Ohio vehicle registration
 - 7. Ohio address listed on federal income tax
 - 8. Has a WHS handicap at a golf club in Ohio
 - 9. Voter registration in Ohio

Future Exemptions

Champion and Runner-Up in each division will be exempt into the 2025 National Links Trust Championship.

Caddies, & Transportation

- Caddies & Carts are permitted. A player may not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his
 or her caddie during the round.
 - Breach of Local Rules result in the general penalty for each hole during which the player is helped by such a
 caddie. If the breach occurs between holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. See Model
 Local Rule H-1.2

Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball

- Players must not wear the following shoes.
 - Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground, regardless of material.
 - Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7.
- List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Local Rule G-1.
- List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures in in affect. Local Rule
 G-3.
