FORMAT

- 54 Hole stroke play competition with two divisions (16-18, 15 & Under)
- There will be 108 players in the 16-18 Division and 36 players in the 15 & Under Division.
- Round 1 Monday, June 9th
- Round 2 Tuesday, June 10th
 - Cut to low 40 & ties for 16-18
 - O Cut to low 14 & ties for 15 & Under
- Round 3 Wednesday, June 11th
- Both divisions will play the same tees at approximately 6,700 yards.

ENTRY FEE & PROCEDURE

- \$270 Entry Fee for all entries, includes range use and daily lunches.
- No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse, all refunds are subject to a \$15 service fee.
- Contestants shall apply online at <u>OhioGolf.org</u>
- Late or incomplete entries not accepted. No telephone or fax entries.
- Deadline for application is June 2, 2025 at 11:59 PM or when field is full.

All entries shall be deemed an invitation and are subject to board approval

CHAMPIONSHIP ACCOLADES

- Overall Champion earns a 5 year exemption into the Ohio Amateur Championship
- Ohio Golf Association trophy awarded to Top 10 Overall & Top 5 15 & Under
- Inclusion to AJGA's Performance Based Entry Recognition System for Overall Results only.
 - O Champion full exemption
 - Top 5 12 performance stars
 - Top 10 8 performance stars
 - Top 15 4 performance stars
 - Top 25 2 performance stars

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a male who has not reached their 19th birthday on or before June 11, 2025
- All entrants must have a WHS handicap index of **5.4 or better**.
- Must be (1) a resident of the state of Ohio or in the case of a minor, their parent/legal guardian must be a resident.
- A resident is defined as meeting four (4) of the following nine (9).
 - 1. Ownership or leasing Ohio residence
 - 2. Proof of payment of utilities of property where residency is being claimed
 - 3. Ohio homestead exemption declared on residence
 - 4. Place of employment in Ohio
 - 5. Ohio driver's license
 - 6. Ohio vehicle registration
 - 7. Ohio address listed on federal income tax
 - 8. Has a WHS handicap at a golf club in Ohio
 - 9. Voter registration in Ohio

Parents, Caddies, & Transportation

- Parents must remain a reasonable distance from play. Parents are prohibited from teeing areas and putting greens
 during tournament play. After the first warning, the player will be disqualified.
- A player may not have a caddie during any tournament round.
- A player must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the committee. See Local Rule G-6.

Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball

- · Players must not wear the following shoes.
 - Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground,
 regardless of material.
 - Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7.
- List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Local Rule G-1.
- List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures in in affect. Local Rule G-3.
