

FORMAT

- 36-hole stroke play competition with two divisions & a Monday practice round.
 - Practice Round – Monday, Jun 16
 - Afternoon shotgun. Entrants can create their own pairing and participate in an informal four-ball. *subject to change*
 - Round 1 – Tuesday, June 17, morning tee times.
 - Round 2 – Wednesday, June 18, morning tee times.
- Senior division (Ages 55+) – Approximate yardage of 6,700 yards.
- Super Senior division (Ages 65+) – Approximate yardage of 6,400 yards.
- Field size is limited to 84 players.
- Champion of Senior Division will be exempt for 2025, 2026, & 2027 Ohio Amateur Championship

ENTRY FEE & PROCEDURE

- \$425 Entry Fee for all entries
 - Range use, cart fees, & lunch for Monday-Tuesday, & breakfast on Wednesday are included.
- No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse, all refunds are subject to a \$15 service fee.

****All entries shall be deemed an invitation and are subject to board approval****

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a male who has reached their 55th birthday on or before June 17.
- All entrants must have an active WHS handicap index of 6.4 or better.
- Must be a resident of the state of Ohio as defined below.
- A resident is defined as meeting four (4) of the following nine (9).
 1. Ownership or leasing Ohio residence
 2. Proof of payment of utilities of property where residency is being claimed
 3. Ohio homestead exemption declared on residence
 4. Place of employment in Ohio
 5. Ohio driver's license
 6. Ohio vehicle registration
 7. Ohio address listed on federal income tax
 8. Has a WHS handicap at a golf club in Ohio
 9. Voter registration in Ohio

Registration

- Players must register at CC of the North on the date of the practice round, June 16, 2025.
- Players may call or email the OGA to pre-register if they are unable to play the practice round.
- Failing to register may result in an alternate replacing that player.

Caddies, & Transportation

- Caddies are permitted. A player may not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round.
 - Breach of Local Rules result in the general penalty for each hole during which the player is helped by such a caddie. If the breach occurs between holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. See Model Local Rule H-1.2
- Automotive transportation is permitted

Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball

- Players must not wear the following shoes.
 - Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground, regardless of material.
 - Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7.
- List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Local Rule G-1.
- List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures in in affect. Local Rule G-3.
