FORMAT

- 36-hole competition with a field size of 176 players (88 teams)
 - o Round 1 Monday, September 8
 - Round 2 Tuesday, September 9
- Championship includes three gross divisions and one net division.
 - Overall Gross Approximate yardage of 7,000 yards
 - Senior Gross (Ages 55+) Approximate yardage of 6,500 yards
 - Super Senior Gross (Ages 65+) Approximate yardage of 6,100 yards
 - Overall Net Approximate yardage of 6,500 yards unless a player is 65 years or older in which they will have option to move up to Super Senior tees.
- Overall Gross winners will be exempt for the 2026, 2027, & 2028 Ohio Amateur Championship

ENTRY FEE & PROCEDURE

- \$500 Team entry fee
 - Range use, cart fees, & lunches included
- Practice rounds can be booked between August 25 & September 7. Practice round fee is \$70 including cart. Contact club for availability,
- No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse, all refunds are subject to a \$15 service fee.
- Contestants, including exempt players, shall apply online at <u>OhioGolf.org</u>

All entries shall be deemed an invitation and are subject to board approval

<u>Deadline for application is September 1, 2025 at 11:59 PM</u>

ELIGIBILITY

- Senior players and Super Senior players must have reached respective age requirements by September 8, 2025.
- Must be a resident of the state of Ohio defined below.
- A resident is defined as meeting four (4) of the following nine (9).
 - 1. Ownership or leasing Ohio residence
 - 2. Proof of payment of utilities of property where residency is being claimed
 - 3. Ohio homestead exemption declared on residence
 - 4. Place of employment in Ohio
 - 5. Ohio driver's license
 - 6. Ohio vehicle registration
 - 7. Ohio address listed on federal income tax
 - 8. Has a WHS handicap at a golf club in Ohio
 - 9. Voter registration in Ohio

Caddies, & Transportation

- Caddies are permitted. A player may not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round.
 - Breach of Local Rules result in the general penalty for each hole during which the player is helped by such a
 caddie. If the breach occurs between holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. See Model
 Local Rule H-1.2
- Motorized transportation is permitted

Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball

- Players must not wear the following shoes.
 - Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground,
 regardless of material.
 - Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7.
- List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Local Rule G-1.
- List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures in in affect. Local Rule
 G-3.
