FORMAT

- **54-hole stroke play competition with two divisions. Senior division ranked by WAGR.**
 - Round 1 – Monday, June 22
 - Round 2 – Tuesday, June 23
 - Round 2 – Wednesday, June 18
- Senior division (Ages 55+) – Approximate yardage of 6,400 yards.
- Super Senior division (Ages 65+) – Approximate yardage of 6,200 yards.
- Field size is limited to 120 players.
- Champion of Senior Division will be exempt for 2025, 2026, & 2027 Ohio Amateur Championship
- For practice rounds contact the golf shop at 513-353-2384. Weekend rate \$84, weekday \$79

ENTRY FEE & PROCEDURE

- \$360 Entry Fee for all entries
 - Range use, cart fees
- No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse, all refunds are subject to a \$15 service fee.
- Contestants, including exempt players, shall apply online at OhioGolf.org

****All entries shall be deemed an invitation and are subject to board approval****

Deadline for application is June 11, 2026 at 11:59 PM

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a male who has reached their 55th birthday on or before June 22.
- All entrants must have an active WHS handicap index of 6.4 or better at a club in Ohio.
- Must be a resident of the state of Ohio as defined below.
- A resident is defined as meeting four (4) of the following nine (8).
 1. Ownership or leasing Ohio residence
 2. Proof of payment of utilities of property where residency is being claimed
 3. Ohio homestead exemption declared on residence
 4. Place of employment in Ohio
 5. Ohio driver's license
 6. Ohio vehicle registration
 7. Ohio address listed on federal income tax
 8. Voter registration in Ohio

Registration

- Players must register at Miami View GC on the date of round 1, June 22, 2026.
- Failing to register may result in an alternate replacing that player.

Caddies, & Transportation

- Caddies are permitted. A player may not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round.
 - Breach of Local Rules result in the general penalty for each hole during which the player is helped by such a caddie. If the breach occurs between holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. See Model Local Rule H-1.2
- Automotive transportation is permitted

Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball

- Players must not wear the following shoes.
 - Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground, regardless of material.
 - Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7.
- List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Local Rule G-1.
- List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures in in affect. Local Rule G-3.
