FORMAT

- 54-hole WAGR ranked stroke play competition with a field size of 84 and a cut after 36 holes
 - Round 1 – Monday, June 29
 - Round 2 – Tuesday, June 30 - Field cut to low 40 & ties following round completion
 - There will be no cut if field size does not exceed 54 players
 - Round 3 – Wednesday, July 1
- Approximate yardage of 6,100 yards
- THIS IS A WALKING ONLY CHAMPIONSHIP

ENTRY FEE & PROCEDURE

- \$300 Entry Fee for all entries
 - Range use & lunch's included (Round 3 lunch only for those who make the cut)
- Practice rounds can be booked between June 9 & 28. Practice round fee is \$75 including cart. Contact club for availability (513) 755-2582
- No refunds after the deadline unless submitted with a medical excuse, all refunds are subject to a \$15 service fee.
- Contestants shall apply online at OhioGolf.org
- Mid-Am's will be eligible to win trophies in both divisions, however, they will only be paid out in one.

****All entries shall be deemed an invitation and are subject to board approval****

Deadline for application is June 18, 2026 at 11:59 PM

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a Female
- Mid Am Division participants must have reached their 25th birthday on or before June 29th
- All entrants must have an active WHS handicap index of 12.4 or better.
- Must have an active GHIN account at a club in Ohio.
- Must be a resident of the state of Ohio as defined below.
- A resident is defined as meeting four (4) of the following nine (8).
 1. Ownership or leasing Ohio residence
 2. Proof of payment of utilities of property where residency is being claimed
 3. Ohio homestead exemption declared on residence
 4. Place of employment in Ohio
 5. Ohio driver's license
 6. Ohio vehicle registration
 7. Ohio address listed on federal income tax
 8. Voter registration in Ohio

Caddies, & Transportation

- Caddies are permitted. A player may not have another player who has or will compete in the same round as his or her caddie during the round.
- During a round, a player or caddie must not ride on any form of motorized transportation except as authorized or later approved by the committee. Local Rule G-6
 - Breach of Local Rules result in the general penalty for each hole during which the player is helped by such a caddie. If the breach occurs between holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole. See Model Local Rule H-1.2

Shoes & Specifications of Club & Ball

- Players must not wear the following shoes.
 - Traditional spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground, regardless of material.
 - Spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course. Rule 4.3. Model Local Rule G-7.
- List of conforming driver heads: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Local Rule G-1.
- List of conforming golf balls: Local Rules as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures in in affect. Local Rule G-3.
